

Have You Reviewed/Elected Your 2023 Benefits?

Open enrollment for the 2023 calendar year is underway and continues through the end of the day on Friday, November 18. Now is the perfect time to review your benefits for the coming year and decide if your current elections still make sense for you and your family.

Visit the Workterra enrollment site to:

- Enroll in, make changes to, or drop medical, dental, vision, life insurance, and/or legal coverages.
- Waive medical coverage and elect the opt-out payment.
- Add or drop dependents from your medical, dental, and vision coverage.
- Enroll in a health care flexible spending account (FSA) or dependent care spending account (DCSA). If you want to

have an FSA or DCSA in 2023, you *must* enroll during the open enrollment period.

Plus, this year you can <u>increase your supplemental life insurance</u> <u>coverage</u> without providing evidence of insurability.

And remember: Open enrollment is the only time you can make benefits choices for 2023, unless you have a <u>qualifying status</u> <u>change</u>.
